Artifacts and exhibitions are meticulously displayed to spotlight products, way of life, and customs of what Korat is known for. As reflected in the Korat provincial slogan, visitors can wander around to pay tribute to Thao Suranaree (across the street), shop for fine silk, taste Korat rice noodles (Phat Mi Korat), view the modern interpretation of Phimai Sanctuary, and witness Dan Kwian pottery. The RueanKorat Chalermwattana house is a replica of the 111-year-old 'Father Kong' traditional Korat-style house. The original house, located at Nakhon Ratchasima Rajabhat University, receives the 2018 Architectural Conservation Award from the Association of Siamese Architects (ASA).
